The Living Legends Award of 2011 presented to Billy Nunn at Las Vegas Annual BMA Award Ceremony.

Billy Nunn, co-writer of single, "Mary Jane", is first generation Original Stone City Band. Awarded Gold Album 1979, for contributing to the creation of that orchestrated funk sound of, "The Late King of Punk Funk Rick James' ", first album "Come and Get It" selling over 500,000 copies. At the request of Rick James, before his untimely death. Billy & Rick pick various Original Stone City Band members for a reunion tour. Billy continued Rick James' last request, and The Original Stone City Band's first show ever without Rick in Buffalo NY 2005.

Billy Nunn co-wrote the song "All Night Long" along with Philip Bailey of (Earth Wind And Fire) and brother Bobby Nunn (Splendor Album 1978)
